

A Community Led Plan (CLP) is an action plan developed by the local community, based on widespread consultation. It sets out a vision for your area to take action on and steps to make your local community a better place.

ACTion with Communities in Cumbria (ACT) can support communities by offering the following free CLP service.

What we provide:

Launching the project

- Details of relevant contacts at Local Authorities and other key agencies.
- Guidance sheets and video case study.
- Support to access grant funding.

Evidence for your plan

- Questionnaire guide
- Comments on consultation process and draft questionnaire.

Action plan writing

- Comments on your draft action plan.

Delivering your plan

- Signposting to sources of information or funding.
- Your action plan added to county CLP database.
- Finished Plan on the ACT website.

We will also provide

- Advice throughout the CLP process by phone and email.
- Grants towards the cost of producing your plan.
- We can also come out to meet your group, answer questions and deliver workshops on Consultation and Action Planning, however, we will need to charge for this service.

What we need from you:

- A named contact for your CLP and to be copied in to notes from all CLP meetings.
- For you to plan and budget for the production of your CLP.
- For you to contact key officers in Local Authorities and relevant agencies at start of process.
- For you to use at least three different ways of consulting people in your community.
- For you to share your draft action plan with ACT and specific contacts at the district and county council, and any other relevant organisations.
- A copy of your finished plan.
- Feedback from you about delivery of your action plan; successes, challenges etc.
